



BIG GOOSE HUNTER MANAGEMENT AREA

August 15, 2026 —May 31, 2027

For take of *Antelope, Deer, Game Bird, Small Game, & Turkey* with **Limited Range Weapons ONLY**
- See Commission Regulation for each species hunting dates



General Rules

- Each hunter must possess a valid permission slip while in the field
- Each hunter must display a valid vehicle pass in the window
- Park only in DESIGNATED parking areas (see map).
- Hunters must follow posted SCLT property rules until they are within the HMA boundary.
- Hunters must enter and exit the HMA through the green gate in the NW corner of the HMA (see map).
- **Limited Range Weapons Only**-Archery Equipment, Shotguns, and traditional Muzzleloaders (no in-line muzzleloaders allowed).
- Non-hunting, non-permitted persons may accompany a permitted hunter with a valid permission slip as long as they are not in possession of a firearm or archery equipment.
- Hunters must sign in when using the HMA. Use QR code at top right corner or Ranch Rules or at gate.



Restrictions

- No take of ANY OTHER SPECIES not listed or any other activities (including collecting antlers) without landowner written permission
- Preseason scouting is not allowed
- Blinds or tree stands are not allowed. Temporary portable blinds may be used, but must be removed each day
- Any commercial activity, including outfitting or guiding is not allowed
- Do not shoot in the direction of, or within 100 yards of, livestock or buildings
- Do not damage range improvements or harass livestock
- No camping or open fires; day use only.
- Abide by all signs and posted areas.
- No littering—carry out everything you bring in, including shotgun hulls.

Big Goose Specific Rules

- Hunters must sign in each day before hunting (use QR code at the green gate, on the ranch rules or follow the link found on the Game and Fish website) -
- Hunters that hold a valid permission slip can take all species listed in the Big Goose HMA Ranch Rules with a proper license and during the season for that species. For example, if a hunter holds a deer license and a deer permission slip and also has a game bird license, the hunter could also hunt game birds during the two day permission slip period if game birds were in season.
- Permission slips are issued on a first come first served basis for a 2 day block. Hunters can hold a max of 5 permission slips for this HMA.



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After Harvest

- Please fill out carcass coupon and landowner coupon. Drop landowner coupon in the box beside the green entrance gate.
- **Be respectful of other users and don't leave entrails or carcasses in visible areas. Don't drag animals on trails and roads if bloody. Clean up blood in and around parking areas and on walking trails.**
- This is a high use area with a diverse group of people. Responsible and respectful hunter behavior is vital to keeping this opportunity open to hunters in the future.



Definitions

- **Take:** means hunt, pursue, catch, capture, shoot, fish, seine, trap, kill, or possess, or attempt to hunt, pursue, catch, capture, shoot, fish, seine, trap, kill or possess.
- **Established road:** means any road or trail that has been graded or constructed to carry motor vehicles or on which repeated motor vehicle traffic has created well defined tracks.
- **Designated road:** means only established roads that are marked with a white arrow sign as open to motor vehicles. Roads not marked with a white arrow sign are closed to motor vehicles.
