



HART MONOLITH RANCH HUNTER MANAGEMENT AREA

Open **August 15, 2025 thru January 18, 2027** for the take of **Antelope** in hunt area **37 or 44**, **white-tailed deer** in hunt area **77**, **Elk** in area **8**, **Moose** in area **38**, and **Waterfowl** on City of Laramie property only during specific seasons as published in the **2026** Game and Fish Commission Regulations



General Rules

- Each hunter must possess a valid permission slip while in the field
- Each hunter must display a valid vehicle pass in the window
- Drive only on DESIGNATED roads (see map)
- Park only in DESIGNATED parking areas (see map)
- Hunting is by foot only
- Leave gates as you find them
- Non-hunting, non-permitted persons may accompany a permitted hunter with a valid permission slip
- GPS/Mapping Service is highly recommended to access this property
- No overnight camping and campfires
- **No littering** - carry out everything you bring in
- Abide by all signs and posted areas
- Hunters are urged to use lead-free ammunition



Restrictions

- No take of ANY OTHER SPECIES or any other activities (including collecting antlers) without landowner written permission
- Preseason scouting is not allowed
- Access within closed areas (see map) is not allowed
- Driving on closed roads or behind closed area gates or signs is not allowed
- Drive on designated roads only (marked by white arrow)
- Use or construction of blinds or tree stands is prohibited
- Any commercial activity, including outfitting or guiding is not allowed
- Do not shoot in the direction of, or within 100 yards of, livestock or buildings
- Drive on designated roads only
- No travel through HMA to take wildlife not listed on permission slip

Hart Monolith Ranch Specific Rules

- Anyone without Department permission or failure to display the vehicle permission pass on their dash shall be subject to trespass charges
- One permission slip will allow a hunter with multiple licenses to take additional animals of the same species provided the permission slip is less restrictive than the license. (Additional doe/fawn antelope licenses may be filled by a holder of a single "any" antelope permission slip. But a buck whitetail may not be taken by a doe/fawn permission slip holder.)
- Access only during dates specified on permission slip for current year
- Hunters may receive either a Monolith or a Spiegelberg Ranch HMA antelope permission slip. Not Both
- Violation of Ranch Rules will result in denial of their access to HMA in subsequent years

- Blood Samples: Hunters are reminded that the Department is conducting brucellosis testing on elk. Hunters need to collect a blood sample and submit for testing.
- CWD Samples: Hunters are reminded that the Department is collecting CWD samples from deer and elk



Definitions

- **Take:** means hunt, pursue, catch, capture, shoot, fish, seine, trap, kill, or possess, or attempt to hunt, pursue, catch, capture, shoot, fish, seine, trap, kill or possess.
- **Established road:** means any road or trail that has been graded or constructed to carry motor vehicles or on which repeated motor vehicle traffic has created well defined tracks.
- **Designated road:** means only established roads that are marked with a white arrow sign as open to motor vehicles. Roads not marked with a white arrow sign are closed to motor vehicles.
- **Wet or muddy road:** all roads are closed when conditions are wet or muddy.
